Back Numbers

Visit the Show Office to pick up your back numbers. PLEASE NOTE: Back numbers will be issued after a copy of the horse's health papers are received by NCHA at healthdocs@nchacutting.com along with a form of payment left to cover practice works and stalls at the end of the show. All competition horses must have a back number. Back numbers should be pinned to the saddle pad on the horse's left side. *** If a rider crosses the timeline without the correct, assigned back number for the horse being shown, the rider will receive a warning. Subsequent occurrences during the event will result in a \$500 fine per occurrence. (i.e.- second offense is \$500 fine, third offense is an additional \$500 fine, etc.)

RV PARKING

RULES

RED VIP LOT WILL BE AVAILABLE 11/9

- Payment due upon arrival
- Spaces in North Red Lot and Yellow Lot D include 30/50-amp power, water and sewer; Lot 1 includes water and electric only
- There are no drive-through spaces. (No connected trailers in back-to-back spaces.)
- Cash or Checks payable to **City of Fort Worth** at Will Rogers, or **Fort Worth Convention Center** at the convention center (no two-party checks allowed)
- Mastercard, Visa, Discover and American Express credit cards are accepted
- No Reservations accepted
- Rent accepted only when living quarters are present
- Some outlets are in groups of four and eight, so some RVs may be parked three or four RV lengths from outlets
- RV owners responsible for bringing own extension cords, hoses and supplies
- Electrical adapters are available through Will Rogers for \$20 per adapter
- No RV parking will be allowed in unmarked spaces or between barns
- It is against the law to tamper with locked power boxes or to make unauthorized conversions

No dumping of gray or black water into the street is permitted. Violators will be ticketed.

- Lot 1 (Swine Barn): 22 spaces (30 amps; 45 feet maximum). \$35 per night
- Lot 1 (Sheep Barn): 8 spaces (30 amps; 30 feet maximum). \$35 per night
- North Red Lot: 104 full-service spaces (30 or 50 amp). \$70 per night
- Yellow Lot D: 78 full-service spaces (30 or 50 amp). \$70 per night




