ARENA ENTRANCE

The entrance to the Coliseum is located on the west side, providing exhibitors with continuous access to the arena. A map of this entrance will be located at the back gate, and there is signage located throughout the facility.

SHOW OFFICE

Open daily from 7:00 AM to the start of the last set of the day. All payments for stalls, shavings, and practice pen or flag works will take place here. The show office is located in the Exhibit Hall.

Please note that effective July 15, 2023, all payments received by the NCHA will be assessed a nonrefundable transaction fee of 3.0%. However, the fee will be waived if payment is submitted by check, wire transfer or ACH/E-check.

Please lock your vehicles, tack rooms, and have your belongings secure at all times.



RULES

- Payment due upon arrival
- Spaces in North Red Lot and Yellow Lot D include 30/50-amp power, water and sewer; Lot 1 includes water and electric only
- There are no drive-through spaces. (No connected trailers in back-to-back spaces.)
- Cash or Checks payable to City of Fort Worth at Will Rogers, or Fort Worth Convention Center at the
 convention center (no two-party checks allowed)
- . Mastercard, Visa, Discover and American Express credit cards are accepted
- No Reservations accepted
- · Rent accepted only when living quarters are present
- Some outlets are in groups of four and eight, so some RVs may be parked three or four RV lengths from outlets
- RV owners responsible for bringing own extension cords, hoses and supplies
- Electrical adapters are available through Will Rogers for \$20 per adapter
- No RV parking will be allowed in unmarked spaces or between barns
- . It is against the law to tamper with locked power boxes or to make unauthorized conversions

No dumping of gray or black water into the street is permitted. Violators will be ticketed.

- Lot 1 (Sheep Barn): 8 spaces (30 amps; 30 feet maximum). \$35 per night
- North Red Lot: 104 full-service spaces (30 or 50 amp). \$70 per night
- Yellow Lot D: 78 full-service spaces (30 or 50 amp). \$70 per night
